Among all Indian states, Bihar is the one most intimately linked to the Buddha's life, resulting in a trail of pilgrimages which have come to be known as the Buddhist circuit. The Buddha spent five years at Rajgir after having attained enlightenment, and many of the remains at Rajgir commemorate...

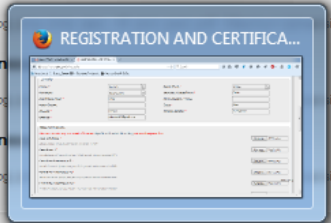
