






Firstly applicant has to create their user profile that is called the Basic Information Performa in


This screen shot shows the option to search name if already exists




This screen shot shows the search results



If the applicant is fresh, he fills in the application form as shown in screen shots below:-







With this form he submits the relevant proof as attachments

And pays the statutory fees by online payment gateway.


3. On Click on "click here to Pay" the payment gateway appear

The departmental authorities process the applications. The registering officer i.e. Labour Inspector physically visit the area and verify the existence of the shop/establishment and grant the registration certificate on finding the applications and document proper.
