

To strengthen safety in chemical factories, Government of Gujarat amended the Gujarat Factories Rules, 1963 in February 1995".

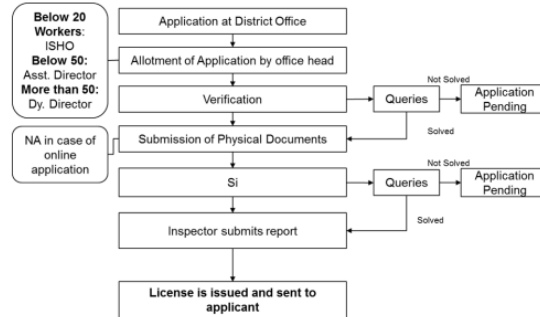
