


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**5. MONITORING- SIZE AND CATEGORY MATRIX****Frequency of inspection and sampling**

Sr no.	Size of Industry	Category of Industry	Frequency of visit and effluent sampling
1	Small Scale	Red	Once in 12 Months
2	Small Scale	Orange	Once in 3 years
3	Non - Polluting SSI/tiny units covered under procedure of simplified consent (small scale)	Green	Once in 3 years on random check basis
4	Large & Medium Scale	Red	Once in 3 Months
5	Large & Medium Scale	Orange	Once in 6 Months
6	Large & Medium Scale	Green	Once in 12 Months

**Notes:**

- (1) Sampling frequency for air emission (point source and ambient) shall be in accordance with the details given in the CPCB Document entitled "Emission Regulations Part - III" December, 1985. SPCB / PCC may specify sampling frequency separately for the industries not covered in these documents.
- (2) Industry be directed to submit monitoring reports on monthly basis and as per the monitoring frequency and parameters stipulated in the consent order.
- (3) Depending on the manpower and availability of resource / infrastructure etc. SPCBs may improve upon the frequency as may be necessary.
