MAHARASHTRA RIGHT TO PUBLIC SERVICES ACT, 2015.

No. ENT.2016/C.R.101/T-1.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Maharashtra Right To Public Services Act, 2015 (Mah. 31 of 2015), the Government of Maharashtra hereby notify the public services rendered by the Revenue and Forests Department through the subordinate Revenue offices, along with the stipulated time limits for providing such public services, the Designated officers, First Appellate Authorities and Second Appellate Authorities, as specified in the Schedule appended herewith, for the purposes of the said Act.
