Remarks:

As seen in the attached notice from the Law and Judiciary Department, Maharashtra and the screenshot below, the strength of District Judges, Ad-hoc Judges, CJSD and CJJD is now 2016/2094 (1789+227 = 2016) or 96%. The selection list of 227 posts has been finalized and their character and police verification is completed. Hence 90% of the vacancies in District courts have been filled up.

With reference to above mentioned subject, I am to state that vide letter under reference current status has been sought by the Department of Industry. In view of information received from the Hon'ble High Court, the working strength as on 17.06.2016 is mentioned in following table.

In the selection process 2015, the M.P.S.C. has recommended 227 candidates. The process of appointing those 227 candidates for the posts of C.J.J.D. and J.M.F.C., is under process. So far character verification and police verification is completed and the appointment procedure is underway and it would be completed shortly, on or prior to August 2016. Thereby the working strength would be 2016 i.e. 96%. Hence, the information in regard to DIPP recommendation No. 330.
