S.O. 61, dated 25th February 2016— In pursuance of implementation of final Business Reforms Action Plan for 2015-16 received from the Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion, Ministry of Industry & Commerce, Government of India, no continuous second inspection of any factory/Industrial Establishment will be made by the same inspector under the following Labour Acts:-

- I. The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976
- II. The Factories Act, 1948
- III. The Minimum Wages Act, 1948
- IV. The Shops and Establishment Act, 1953
- V. The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965
- VI. The Payment of Wages Act, 1936
- VII. The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972
- VIII. The Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970
- IX. The Maternity Benefit Act, 1961

Provided that if the inspection is required, an official senior to the inspector concerned who had carried out the inspection earlier, will perform the necessary inspection with the prior permission of the Labour Commissioner:

Provided further that in case of factories / industrial establishments employing 10 or more workmen, a single joint inspection may be carried out by the inspectors under their local authorities for the inspectors under their local authorities for the above mentioned Acts.

3. This notification will come in to force from the date of issue but will not be applicable to such cases (such as accidents etc.) where it is compulsory to conduct the inspection within a stipulated time period under the relevant Act.

औद्योगिक नीति एवं संवर्द्धन विभाग, वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार द्वारा वर्ष 2016 के लिए निरूपित व्यवसाय सुधार कार्य योजना (Business Reform Action Plan) के अन्तर्गत उद्योगों / स्थानाओं / कारखानों को निम्न, मध्यम तथा उच्च श्रेणी के जोखिम वाले इकाइयों में वर्गीकरण करते हुए विभिन्न श्रम अधिनियमों में निरीक्षण की व्यवस्था का पुनरीक्षण का परामर्श दिया गया है। तदनुसार बिहार सरकार की अधिसूचना संख्या 1/एफ1-103/2016श्र0सं0 - 526 दिनांक 10.02.16 के द्वारा उद्योगों / स्थापनाओं / कारखानों को विभिन्न श्रेणी के जोखिम वाले इकाइयों में वर्गीकरण के लिए मापदण्ड निर्धारित किए गए हैं। इसी क्रम में राज्य में उद्योगों एवं वाणिज्य गतिविधियों के विकास के दृष्टिकोण से विभिन्न श्रम अधिनियमों के अन्तर्गत निरीक्षण की व्यवस्था के संदर्भ में निम्न दिशा निर्देश दिए जाते हैं:-

1. 10 या 10 से कम कर्मचारी नियोजित करने वाले उद्योगों / स्थापनाओं / कारखानों में किसी भी निरीक्षी पदाधिकारी द्वारा बिना श्रमायुक्त के पूर्वानुमति के Individual inspection (वैयक्तिक निरीक्षण) नहीं किया जाएगा।
2. मुख्यालय द्वारा random selection के आधार पर प्रत्येक माह में निरीक्षण किए जाने वाले उद्योगों / स्थापनाओं / कारखानों की सूची संबंधित पदाधिकारियों को ई-मेल के माध्यम से अवगत कराई जाएगी।
3. सामान्य निरीक्षण कार्य संयुक्त दल द्वारा किया जाएगा। निरीक्षण के उपरान्त निरीक्षण रिपोर्ट 48 घंटे के अन्दर विभागीय वेबसाइट पर upload किया जाना अनिवार्य होगा।
4. संयुक्त दल में संबंधित क्षेत्र के श्रम अधीक्षक, कारखाना निरीक्षक तथा श्रम प्रवर्तन पदाधिकारी शामिल होंगे और एक ही visit में सभी श्रम अधिनियमों के अन्तर्गत निरीक्षण का कार्य पूरा कर लिया जाएगा। संयुक्त दल का समन्वय तथा नेतृत्व संबंधित श्रम अधीक्षक करेंगे।

5. निरीक्षण दल द्वारा निरीक्षण प्रपत्र में हीं निरीक्षण किया जाएगा।
6. किसी गंभीर प्रकृति के मामले मुख्यालय में प्रतिवेदित किए जाने की स्थिति में श्रमायुक्त की पूर्वानुमति से ही ऐसे मामले में अलग से निरीक्षण की कार्रवाई की जा सकेगी।

Step 5: The system displays district-wise list of establishments automatically selected that need to be inspected based on computerized risk assessment. Certain logic are built into the system which includes that “High Risk” category of establishments will be inspected once every year whereas “Medium Risk” and “Low Risk” category will be inspected once in 3 years and 5 years respectively.
