B. Particulars of Consent to Operate of the industry

A. MAIN CONDITIONS

1. This consent is not valid for getting power load from the Punjab State Electricity Board or for getting loan from the financial institutions.
2. The industry shall apply for renewal/further extension of consent at least one month before expiry of the consent.
3. The industry shall ensure that there is no public nuisance created in the area due to its poultry activity.
4. The Project Proponent shall ensure that the droppings are not stored for longer period to minimize odour problem.
5. The industry shall ensure that at any time the emissions do not exceed the emission standards laid down by the Board from time to time.
6. The adequacy and efficiency of the air pollution control device will be the entire responsibility of the industry.
7. The authorized outlet and the authorized fuel being used shall not be changed without the prior written permission of the Board.
8. The industry shall not discharge any fugitive emissions. All gases shall be emitted through a stack of suitable height, as per the norms fixed by the Board from time to time.
9. The industry shall provide port-holes, platforms and/or other necessary facilities as may be required for collecting the samples of emissions from any chimney, flue or duct or any other outlets.

Specifications of the port-holes shall be as under:-

- i) The sampling ports shall be provided at atleast 8 times chimney diameter downstream and 2 times upstream from the flow disturbance. For a rectangular cross section the equivalent diameter (De) shall be calculated from the following equation to determine upstream, downstream distance:-

$$De = 2 LW$$

$$L+W$$

Where L= length in mts. W= Width in mts.

- ii) The sampling port shall be 7 to 10 cm in diameter.

17 The industry shall get its suspended particulate matter in the emissions tested from Board's lab for all the stacks and submit compliance to the Board within two months and thereafter get the emissions analyzed atleast twice in a year.

18 The existing control equipment shall be altered or replaced in accordance with the direction of the Board, and no control equipment or chimney shall be altered or as the case may be erected or re-erected except with the previous

approval of the Board.

19 The pollution control devices shall be interlocked with the manufacturing process of the industry.

20 The industry shall make arrangement for parking within the premises.

21 The industry shall not cause any nuisance/traffic hazard in vicinity of the area.

22 The industry shall comply with the provisions as per section 94 of the Environment (Protection) Rules 1986 regarding noise limits for generator sets run with diesel as published by Central Pollution Control Board.

23 This consent is issued in the supersession of the consents earlier granted to M/s S.B Poultry Farm, Village Jakhepal, Tehsil Rajpura, Distt. Patiala vide no. RO/PTA/APC/09/366 dated 26.3.2009.

24 The Board reserves the right to revoke the consent granted to the industry at any time, in case the industry is found violating the provisions of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended from time to time.

B. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The industry shall comply with any other conditions laid down or directions issued in due course by the Board under the provisions of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

2. Nothing in this consent shall be deemed to preclude the institution of any legal action nor relieve the applicant from any responsibilities, liabilities or penalties to which the applicant is or may be subjected to under this or any other Act.

3. Any amendments/revisions made by the Board in the emission/stack height standards shall be applicable to the industry from the date of such amendments/revisions.

4. The industry shall dispose off its solid wastes generated by the burning of fuel in a proper manner and to the satisfaction of the Board to avoid public nuisance and air pollution problem.

5. The industry shall ensure that no air pollution problem or public nuisance is created in the area due to discharge of emissions from the industry.

6. The air pollution control equipment shall be kept at all time in good running condition.

7. The industry shall provided adequate arrangements for fighting the accidental leakage/discharge of any air pollutant/gas/ liquids from the vessels, mechanical equipment's etc, which are likely to cause environmental pollution.

8. The industry shall put display Board indicating Environmental data at the main entrance gate.

9. The industry shall get the adequacy of pollution control measures assessed from the Board at least once in a year and give compliance.
