Q211 - Phase out static check posts and implement random checking by mobile squads

Comment:

- Madhya Pradesh commercial tax department has 29 checkpost out of which 15 are integrated checkpost. 6 mobile squads function as Anti Evasion Bureau.
- The integrated checkpost being deployed by the state of Madhya Pradesh has been a matter of appreciation across country and other states including Gujarat, Punjab, Bihar, Kerala etc have shown interest to replicate the model. (Letter from Bihar attached for reference, News Coverage on Gujarat Study Team)
- As part of process, 5 departments of the State Government of Madhya Pradesh (Road Transport, Commercial Tax, Forest, Mandi & Mineral) are involved in entry/exit checking & pass-through of vehicles under single roof called integrated checkpost. The checkposts are computerized and fully automated managed by independent vendor (IL&FS) on PPP (Public Private Partnership) Model.
- Commercial Tax Department gets only 40 seconds per vehicle on application screen to complete action / approval. If no action is taken in the allotted timeframe, the vehicle is assumed to be auto-approved by the department. On an average within Two & Half minute, a vehicle is passed through the integrated checkpost after necessary approvals from 5 departments.
- For Commercial Tax Department, only 3-4% of vehicles passing through the check post are detained / checked based on the pre-defined risk parameters or past behaviour of vehicle / dealer captured in the system. Thus, random checking of vehicles as recommended in "Ease of Doing Business" is already in place in the department and more than 96% of vehicles are passed without departmental intervention.
- The Integrated Checkpost concept deployed in the state is under PPP Model and the contract has been awarded by the government of Madhya Pradesh for a period of 10 Years.
- The model has provided a huge amount of relief to transporters / dealers as they are now required to stop their vehicle at only one place where 5 departments work in tandem to process and provide necessary approvals within approximately Two & Half minute per vehicle. Therefore any attempt to close or amend the integrated check posts would introduce the issue to multiple checkpoints for the vehicle / dealer by different departments.
- Integrated check posts is therefore a tool for ensuring "Ease of Doing Business" implemented proactively by the State Government of Madhya Pradesh. Madhya Pradesh has been a pioneer state in effective implementation of Integrated Checkpost as a result of which other states are following the model.

- For Commercial Tax Department, only 3-4% of vehicles passing through the check post are detained / checked based on the pre-defined risk parameters or past behaviour of vehicle / dealer captured in the system. Thus, random checking of vehicles is already in place in the department and more than 96% of vehicles are passed without departmental intervention.



(B) News Coverage of Gujrat Officials Study Visit of Integrated Checkposts of MP:

Bhopal: Following construction of 24 new border check-posts, integrated checking facility will become available in Madhya Pradesh. Madhya Pradesh will be first state to implement this arrangement.

A study team of Check-post Survey Committee of Gujarat State Transport Department called on additional chief secretary Antony D'sa here today and held detailed discussions regarding establishment of integrated border check-posts in Gujarat.

According to D'sa, the Gujarat delegation informed that computerized arrangements are already there in transport check-posts in their state. They said they have been very much impressed by establishment of integrated check-posts in Madhya Pradesh and intend to adopt the same arrangements in their state. D'sa informed that soon a team of Madhya Pradesh will visit Gujarat to give information about arrangements and procedure for integrated border check-posts' establishment.

They will also impart necessary training. It is noteworthy that construction of 24 integrated border check-posts is underway to make arrangements for tax recovery from commercial vehicles plying on inter-state routes.

The computerised check-posts will recover Transport, Commercial, Forest, Mandi and Mineral Development departments' taxes under one roof. The system evolved to rationalise tax recovery will not only increase revenue of the State Government but will also save the time consumed in checking of commercial vehicles at inter-state check-posts.

It may be mentioned that a delegation of Check-post Survey Committee of Gujarat State Transport Department headed by Gujarat chief secretary Ashok Bhatia and secretary Kishore Trivedi is currently on state's visit.
